

LES PUCES DU DESIGN **41ème EDITION**
FROM 02 to 05 DECEMBER 2021
PARIS EXPO PORTE DE VERSAILLES - 15°

Art. 1 General conditions

The 41st Puces du Design will take place on December 02, 03, 04 and 05 2021 in the hall 03.1 of Paris Expo Portes de Versailles, Paris 15°. Les Puces du Design is an event where antique dealers specialized in contemporary furniture, objects, fashion and accessories will sell original pieces of 20th century : the presence of new objects has to be validated by the organisation, the presence of copy of furniture will be followed by the confiscation of them and the exhibitor concerned could no more participate to the Puces du Design. The exhibitors chosen by the organisation receive a registration form that has to be resent before May 1st. The exhibitors commit to respect, without any restriction nether reserve, the clauses of this regulation and all the new ones that could be imposed by the circumstances and that could be adopted by the organisation in the interest of the fair.

Art. 2 Vintage Design Exhibitors

Are considered as exhibitors, professionals specialized in 1950 to nowadays furniture and objects, or fashion and accessories. French or foreigner exhibitors who have booked a stand will have to respect the nomenclature of the pieces admit to be showed by the organisers.

Art. 3 Selection

Les Puces du Design is concerning the fashion and furniture design of the years '50 to 2000, an innovator and prestigious fair, because of the quality, the originality and the exceptional feature of the pieces presented. In order to maintain this level of quality, the exhibitors commit to present in Les Puces du Design only original pieces of an equivalent quality than the ones they are used to show in this fair; these ones can in any case be pieces unsold in other fairs. For a first registration, a documentation about the objects and designers that will be presented in the fair is requested. The organizers are allowed to refuse pieces that would not answer, among their appreciation, to the quality criteria of the event. The organisation could accept or refuse an exhibitor without invoking the cause.

Art. 4 Reservation and payment

The registration form has to be resent before June 30th 2021 with the payment of the totality of the amount TTC of the space chosen (either by French check or by bank transfer or credit card number for the foreign exhibitors). All the payment remains due unless the organization cancels the show. No stand will be reserved as long as the organisers do not have received the totality of the payment. The exhibitor will be only admitted to take part to the fair when he will have paid the totality of the charges awed.

Art. 5 Cancellation

After acceptance of their request of participation, the exhibitors can not allege to any reimbursement, even if they can not take part to the fair. And the payment of the totality of the stand is due. On the other hand, we undertake to reimburse the full amount paid if the event cannot take place due to a cancellation by the organization or health measures taken by the French government or if the foreign exhibitor is prevented from travelling by health measures taken by the government of his country.

Art. 6 Stand attribution

The assignment of the stands will be done by the organisation. No complaint could be done about this attribution.

Art. 7 Unpacking and packing

The hours for the packing and unpacking will have to be respected : the unpacking should take place from December 1st in the afternoon, the packing will have to take place for everybody from 7h pm on Sunday, December 05th. Each stand will have to be overseen in permanence during the opening hours of the fair and this until the last day of the event included. The exhibitors have to left the place they have rent in the same state that they had found it when they arrived.

Art. 8 Right to the image

Photos / videos will be made about the event; also photos of your stand will be able to serve later to the promotion of the event without limitation of duration: posting, e.mailing, social networks ...

Art.9 Security

All the necessary security measures will be assured by the organisation concerning the general tutelage of the fair when the fair is closed. All the exhibitors have to vigilant and oversee his own goods during the public opening hours and during the unpacking and packing. The exhibitors will have to left in permanence an access to the buildings doors and car parks.

Art. 10 Insurances

A nominative obligatory insurance has to be subscribed with the stand registration. With this, the exhibitors have to subscribe a special insurance for the other risks incurred, in particular the theft, artwork pieces or exhibition material degradation. The exhibitors disengage the responsibility of the organisers in case of fire, explosion, flood, diverse disturbance, and for all element not attributable to the organisers, agents or employees. In particular, «dommages et intérêts» could not be requested to the organisers if the space rent can finally not be occupied by the exhibitors because of events presenting a case of force majeure.

Art. 11 Diverse interdictions

The stands will have to be inhabit exclusively by the person who have signed the registration form, from the beginning to the end of the opening hours of the fair.

Excepted in case of a special and written authorization of the organisers, it is forbidden to the exhibitors :

- to rent all or a part of their stand gratis or with an exchange of money or of favour.
- to sell new editions of objects, furniture or fashion
- to use other space than the one rent by the organization for exhibiting

Art.12 Organisers responsibility

the organisers are allowed, notably in case of force majeure as transport strike, adjourn the fair, modify the opening hours, or exclude the public. They can cancel it or close it before the date planned. In all the cases, the contracts dealt with the exhibitors keep their entire validity and the payment of the stand and of all the other charges are still owed.

Art. 13 Application of this regulation

The organisers are allowed at all the moment to rule on litigious cases, or on he ones not planned in this regulation. These decisions, even if they are verbally transmit are not debatable and immediately executory. The organisers are allowed to change this regulation for the interest of the fair.

Art. 14 Complaints

The exhibitors complaints have to be submitted to the organisers by registered letter within the 8 days after the end of the fair in order to find an amicable solution. After this time, the complaints will be no more receivable. All litigation will depend on the competence of the Tribunal de Commerce de Paris and will be submitted of French law.

Art. 15 Registration

Since the 20th Pucés du Design, the exhibitors who will register to the Pucés du Design forbid themselves to participate to another fair with the same thematic system - fashion and furniture of the '50 to 2000 - that would take place* within the 30 (thirty) days before and after the event organized by the Pucés du Design to which they want to take part.** in case of violation of this commitment, the organizers are allowed to forbid this exhibitor to participate to the Pucés du Design, all the amounts paid by the exhibitor are still acquired by the organizer as an indemnification.

** Except if you have a special authorisation from the organization
